

The Municipality of Ivry-sur-le-Lac introduced a new regulation (2020-115) in 2020 making it mandatory to wash all motorized and non-motorized boats that access its territory's lakes and rivers. The objective is to preserve the quality of the aquatic environment and the integrity of the shorelines by preventing the introduction and spread of invasive foreign species.



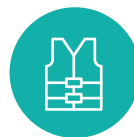
**Check local weather conditions** before planning your outing. Water conditions play an important role in ensuring everyone's safety on the water. Don't get caught off guard!



**All motorboat operators must hold the Pleasure Craft Operator Card (PCOC).** This requirement applies to all types of motorboats, regardless of their size or the power of their motor (including small electric motor boats). The pleasure craft operator card is valid for life: [www.tc.gc.ca](http://www.tc.gc.ca).



In addition to having your PCOC on board, **you are required by law to have safety equipment.** You will find safety equipment that each type of pleasure boat must have on board in order to comply with Transport Canada regulations for pleasure boating: [www.tc.gc.ca/eng/safety](http://www.tc.gc.ca/eng/safety). Check if you have all the compulsory equipment on your boat. Remember, it is a \$250 fine per missing piece of equipment. Also, the operator of a pleasure craft must carry out periodic maintenance of all of their nautical equipment so that everything works properly, thereby reducing the probability of failure.



The most important boating safety gear is **wearing the right size personal flotation device** for each person on board. Wear it, it's a lifesaver!



**Do not consume alcohol or drugs.** Driving while impaired is illegal. Did you know that you could lose your driver's license?



**Reduce your speed near the shore and respect the speed zones** under Schedule 6 - Part 3 of the Federal Vessel Operation Restriction Regulations SOR/2008-120, namely:

- Art. 50** Lac Manitou outside the zones indicated in articles 51 to 53  
**MAXIMUM SPEED 55 KM/H**
- Art. 51** 23m or less from the Lac Manitou shoreline  
**MAXIMUM SPEED 10 KM/H**
- Art. 52** Lac Manitou between North Bay and Adams Point  
**MAXIMUM SPEED 10 KM/H**
- Art. 53** Lac Manitou in the Strait of the island known locally as McCall Island  
**MAXIMUM SPEED 10 KM/H**



**Respect shoreline property owners and other boaters** by reducing the noise and waves produced.



**The practice of a nautical activity generating large waves is not recommended,** and this, in order to limit your impact on the environment and on other users. The use of wave amplification systems (ballast system) on "WAKE" boats is therefore strongly discouraged on Lac Manitou.



**Priority belongs to bathers and non-motorized boats.** Respect safety distances, keep at least 50 meters from swimmers, other non-motorized boats, standing boats or wild animals.

## But first, the decal!

To access **Lac Manitou**, obtaining a decal is MANDATORY for all boaters. To obtain a decal:

- The registration form must be completed and signed;
- Tenants renting for over three (3) months must have remitted a full copy of their lease;
- The decal fee must be paid.

## Then, the washing station!

**Your decal will be given to you by the attendant at the washing station** after having washed the boat, trailer, nautical equipment and provided that all the required documents are duly completed and the decal is paid.

**Washing does not apply to shoreline owners** whose boats remain on their property (or in their boathouse) all winter and which never navigate in other bodies of water. Only for the latter, the decal will be sent to them by mail once the form has been completed, payment received and the undertaking signed.

**Boats stored at dealerships must also be washed** at the Municipality of Ivry-sur-le-Lac's washing station even if they have been previously washed in their warehouses.



**After your visit to the washing station, you can go to the boat launch.** The decal will be required, without it you will be refused entry.

Public access to Lac Manitou is **open seven days a week from late May to mid-October.**

**Although the use of municipal beaches in Ivry-sur-le-Lac is reserved for residents only** and these are accessible at all times, they are not supervised. So make sure that children are always accompanied by responsible persons.

**Dogs and other pets are strictly prohibited on public beaches.**

## Parking

**The boat launch parking must be limited to a few cars** so that users can maneuver with a trailer.

**Parking is prohibited near the landing stage** on the Lac-de-la-Grise road. Drivers can park on more distant streets.

**It is forbidden to park a vehicle in the parking space identified for disabled people** at the City Hall as well as in spaces reserved for staff.

## Nautical sports



**Personal watercraft** : The operator must be at least 16 years of age and must wear a personal flotation device at all times.



**The times at which it is permitted to tow a person are from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. and 4 p.m. to 7 p.m.** When you practice a towed nautical activity, make sure you have a spotter at all times to keep an eye on the person being towed.



To enjoy a pleasant boating experience, the owners and operators of the boat must be able to protect their passengers and other boaters from risk and injury, but also to respect the environment.



**To avoid introducing invasive foreign species,** you must have your boat washed at the washing station in the Municipality of Ivry-sur-le-Lac.



**Respect water bodies** by avoiding throwing your waste in the water.



**According to the management plan of the Ministry of Forests, Fauna and Parks,** in Lac Manitou, the release of lake trout is mandatory.
